1. Nomination

The University offers Spanish as a Foreign Language course with a 33% Erasmus discount. It is also an Official Examination Centre for the Diploma of Spanish as a Foreign Language (Diploma de Español como Lengua Extranjera - DELE) with exams in May and November.

Courses run throughout the year in Zaragoza (Plaza San Francisco campus) but in summer they are held at the tourist resort of Jaca (Huesca) in the Pyrenees.
